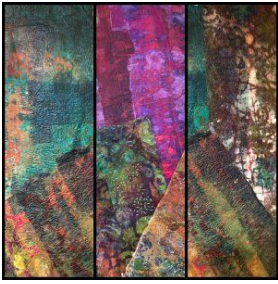
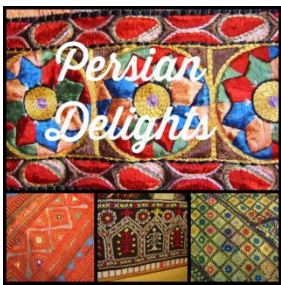


MEG Programme 2021

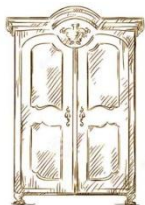
